DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAM:

INTRODUCTION

Acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS) is a chronic, potentially life-threatening condition caused by the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV). By damaging immune system, HIV interferes with body's ability to fight infection and disease. World AIDS Day takes place on 1 December each year. It's an opportunity for people worldwide to unite in the fight against HIV, to show support for people living with HIV, and to commemorate those who have died from an AIDS-related illness. Founded in 1988, World AIDS Day was the first ever global health day.

Theme of World AIDS Day 2025 is "Overcoming disruption, transforming the AIDS response."

OBJECTIVES

- To ensure that everyone is well-served, increase the availability, quality, and acceptability of services for HIV treatment, testing, and prevention.
- To combat the prejudice and isolation suffered by people who are HIV-positive and by important and disadvantaged communities, reform laws, policies, and practices.
- To utilise and modify the "Equalize" message to draw attention to the specific inequities they confront and to push for the remedial measures required.


REPORT

On 6th December 2025, Sant Gajanan Maharaj Nursing College organized a World AIDS Day awareness program under the guidance of teachers and respected faculty members. The program was actively conducted by the students of B. Sc Nursing, GNM, and ANM courses.

The main objective of the program was to spread awareness about AIDS among community people, educate them about its symptoms, modes of transmission, prevention methods, and to remove misconceptions related to the disease.

A rally was organized in the communities of Gadmoushi and Sindewahi. The students enthusiastically participated by carrying banners, placards, and raising awareness slogans to attract public attention. During the rally, students interacted with local residents and provided detailed information about AIDS, its causes, early symptoms, preventive measures, and the importance of safe practices.

The students also emphasized the importance of regular health check-ups, safe blood transfusion practices, use of protective measures, and avoiding stigma and discrimination towards people living with HIV/AIDS. Informative pamphlets were distributed among community members to reinforce the message.



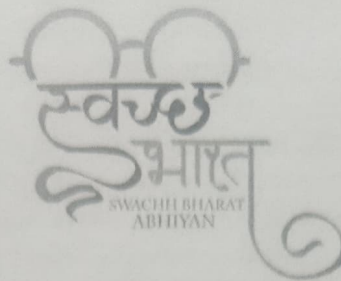
The event concluded with a vote of thanks, expressing gratitude to the Assistant Professor, faculty members, students, and community participants for their active involvement and cooperation.

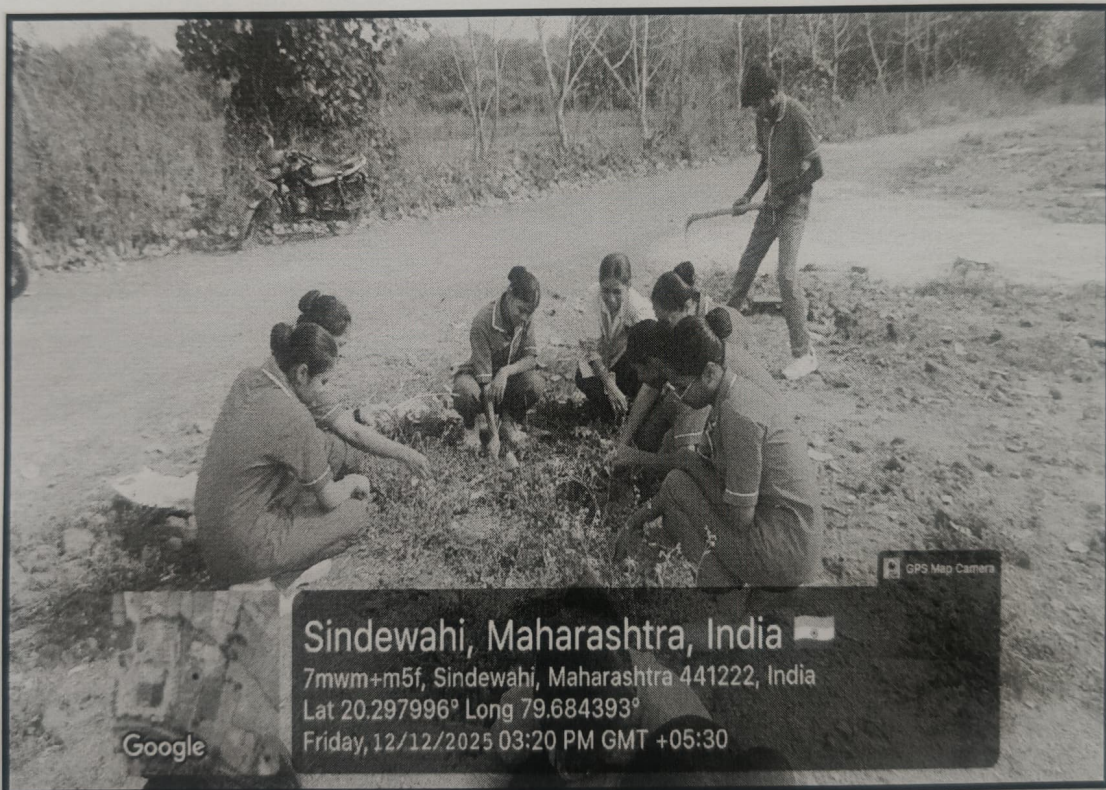

Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM), Swachh Bharat Abhiyan or Clean India Mission is a country-wide campaign initiated by the Government of India on 2 October 2014 to eliminate open defecation and improve solid waste management and to create Open Defecation Free (ODF) villages. The program also aims to increase awareness of menstrual health management.[2] It is a restructured version of the Nirmal Bharat Abhiyan which was launched by the Government of India in 1999, as Total Sanitation Campaign.

OBJECTIVES


- **Eliminate open defecation** by constructing household and community toilets.

- **Improve public health** by reducing sanitation-related diseases.
- **Sustain Open Defecation Free (ODF) status** through continuous monitoring and awareness.
- **Create cleaner villages and cities** to enhance quality of life and boost tourism.
